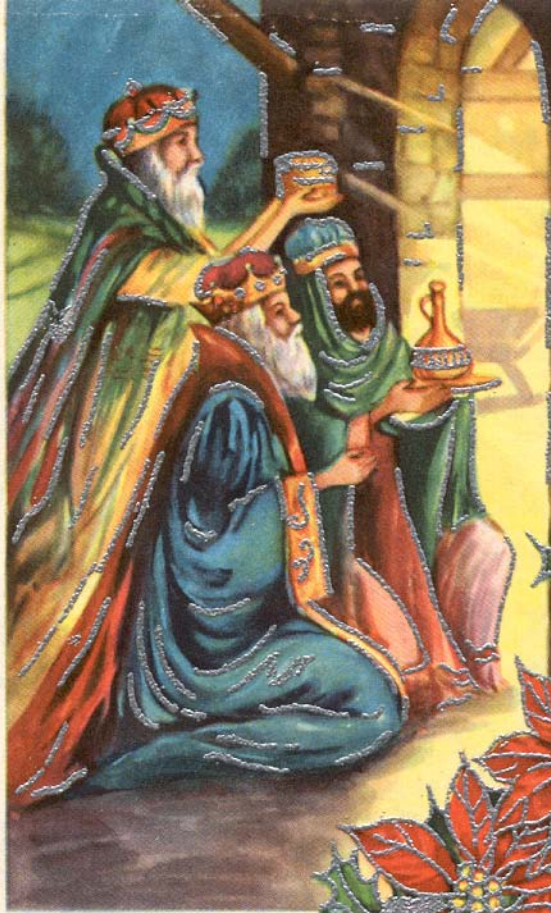


Joyous
